* The parties can mutually agree to changes in the holiday schedule (via text message is sufficient). However, in the absence of an agreement otherwise, the holiday schedule above shall be followed.

** In cases where the parties do not have a roughly equal regular parenting time schedule, the parties should consider each party having parenting time with the children for ½ of the time that the children are out of school over the Christmas holiday. If the children are not yet school age, the school calendar for the district in which the children reside would control.

*** All children shall be present for birthday parenting time. The parent exercising birthday parenting time shall provide all transportation.
